

Seething Airfield Charity Air Day 20th August 2017

Classic Vehicle Display Requirements



Entry, Parking and Exit Procedures

Vehicles may arrive from 08.00 on the day and all vehicles **must be on site by 09.30**. To comply with the health and safety requirements all display vehicles must be in position and access to the classic vehicle display area closed before general public admission opens. In view of this **it will not be possible for any vehicle arriving after 09.45 to enter the classic vehicle area**. Vehicles arriving after this time will have to park in the public car parks.

Entry will **only** be granted to vehicles displaying the correct authorised entry pass. These will be entrant specific. **No pass - No entry – No - discussion!**

Vehicles **must** park in the position indicated by the Seething Airfield stewards/marshals. If you wish to park next to a friend then please arrange to arrive together. Once in position no vehicle will be permitted to move other than under the express direction and supervision of the stewards/marshals.

No vehicle may leave the classic vehicle display area before the end of the flying display (estimated to be around 16.30). Note that the classic vehicle display area **exit barriers will not be removed until the last display aircraft has landed**.

Cancellations

Should it become necessary to cancel the event more than 48 hours before the planned date the organisers will make reasonable efforts to advise booked participants?

If any booked participant knows that they will be unable to attend more than 14 days before the event it would be appreciated if they would advise the organisers (see contacts). This may allow participation by someone on the waiting list.

Insurance/MOT/Vehicle Licensing

All participating vehicles must be covered by a valid certificate of motor insurance which must be fully in force on the day of the event. Vehicles must also be taxed and have a valid MOT certificate. All drivers must hold valid licenses for the type of vehicle they are driving.

The organisers reserve the right to require valid license and insurance documents to be produced for inspection on the day of the event.

Health and Safety

All participants must take responsibility for their own health and safety and the safety and security of their vehicle. Vehicle drivers must take all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of the general public in the vicinity of their vehicle. All participants must comply with local site Health and Safety requirements.

Dogs/Animals

On the advice of the leading animal charities, including the RSPCA, the event is **not** suitable for dogs or other animals. Please do not bring animals to the Airday.

General Terms

- The Organisers reserve the right to refuse entry to any vehicle or person.
- The Organisers reserve the right to cancel or curtail the event at any time.
- The Organisers accept no responsibility for any loss or damage to property or for any personal injury.
- **All participants enter Seething Airfield entirely at their own risk.**
